This workshop is targeted to Public Works workers, Public Utilities, Arborists, and Foresters. Forest pathologist Aaron Bergdahl will discuss pest and disease threats and how to prune to reduce likelihood of decay and maintain town trees for overall health.

Outside location will be used to demonstrate proper techniques to prune trees in town's right of way and gain understanding of how branching relates to loading throughout the tree's structure. A variety of pruning examples will be shown, including discussion by Chris Mooers of Houlton Water Company on pruning techniques with overhead wire interference.
